This degree program is a collaboration between UD and the Thomas Jefferson University (TJU) School of Pharmacy. The courses taken in the first year (and if necessary, in the second year) at TJU will complete the requirements for the B.S. degree from UD while at the same time serve as the first year (and if necessary, the second year) of the Pharmacy program. After the four years are completed at TJU, the student will receive a (PharmD) degree. There are six basic aspects to the application procedure:

1. Successful completion of all Thomas Jefferson University prerequisites.
2. A minimum grade point average of 2.7. However, to be competitive, a student must obtain a grade point average of around 3.3 in the sciences.
3. Completion of prerequisite courses with at least a C in each course.
4. Acceptable PCAT scores (scores in the 70th percentile or higher are very desirable).
5. Completion of formal application (PharmCAS) to Thomas Jefferson for admission into the PharmD program which includes a minimum of two letters of recommendation and a personal statement.
6. Acceptable performance in an interview administered by Thomas Jefferson University's admission committee.

Students who are accepted to the TJU program will change their UD major to the B.S. in Biological Sciences with a concentration in Pharmaceutical Sciences (PS)
